Asylum & Protection	1	<p>We are ONLY permitted to provide limited assistance within the Immigration Rules, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Notifying the Home Office of a change of address - Seeking an extension of Temporary Admission - Applications for permission to work - Travel document applications for people granted humanitarian protection/ exceptional leave to remain - Settlement applications (protection route) 	<p>We are NOT permitted to do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Prepare asylum applications - Enforcement work (bail/removal/banning orders) - Work in relation to illegal entrants/over stayers, removal or deportation from the UK - Work in relation to family reunion - Lodging notices of appeal - Undertaking substantive appeal work, including making representation to or before courts/tribunals - Judicial review work
